

Cookies Policy

Cookies are used on this website. By using our website, you agree that cookies are to be placed on your device as further explained below.

Cookies are small files that a website sends to your computer's web browser while you are navigating through it. They have many different purposes, but mainly, cookies enable you to navigate between pages easily. These cookies may then be stored on your machine to identify your computer.

Cookies used on this website can be either set up by our website and/or by Google Analytics as a third-party. Moreover, these cookies can be "session" or "persistent" cookies: a session cookie is a cookie that is automatically deleted when the user closes the browser, whereas a persistent cookie is a cookie that remains stored in the user's terminal device until it reaches a defined expiration date.

Types of cookies we use

We use cookies that help us to understand how visitors interact with our website by collecting and reporting information anonymously. These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our website, for instance which pages they go to more often, and if they get error messages from web pages.

All information collected by means of these cookies is anonymized, aggregated and only used to develop and track traffic patterns and the volume of use of our website and to improve how our website works. This information is for Facilization's exclusive use and is not shared with any third party or connected to any other information.

They collect the following information:

- Number of times a user has visited the website as well as dates for the first and most recent visit. Used by Google Analytics.
- Register a timestamp with the exact time of when the user accessed the web site. Used by Google Analytics to calculate the duration of a web site visit.
- Register a timestamp with the exact time of when the user leaved the web site. Used by Google Analytics to calculate the duration of a web site visit.
- Throttle the speed of requests to the server.
- Collects data on where the user came from, what search engine was used, what link was clicked and what search term was used. Used by Google Analytics.

Important! The cookies used on this website do not collect Personal Data.
